JOB DESCRIPTION: Full-time, tenure or clinical track position in the Section of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Department of Applied Dental Medicine. Responsibilities include didactic and clinical teaching in the predoctoral program, with some teaching responsibilities for residents in the AEGD, Periodontics and Implant programs, and service to the University. For tenure track appointments independent research and scholarly activity is also expected. Working in collaboration with other faculty, both in research and teaching, is strongly encouraged. Extramural faculty practice is available.

TERM OF CONTRACT: Full-time, term or continuing.

SALARY RANGE: Commensurate with qualifications.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED: A D.M.D. or D.D.S. degree or equivalent, specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery eligibility or certification is required. Previous teaching experience and/or a record of research accomplishment through publication and external funding are desirable. Applicants must be licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Illinois, or be able to meet the requirements for permanent licensure in Illinois.
