School of Education

School of Education Dean's Scholarship (\$1,000) Applicants must be in their internship/capstone semester, have a 3.5 GPA while in the program at SIUE and be in good standing, & complete the Dean's Scholarship Application including a one-page personal statement. Graduate and undergraduate students are encouraged to apply.

Department of Curriculum & Instruction

Bessie May Briggs Mason Scholarship (\$2,000/yr, up to 4 years) Applicants must be pursuing an education degree to become a primary or secondary education teacher, demonstrate financial need and have submitted FAFSA, be a graduate (or soon to be graduate) of Alton High School, & must apply to SIUE and submit all necessary materials to the Office of Admissions.

Eileen E. Brown Scholarship* Applicants must be a full-time student at SIUE with a GPA over 2.5, have a junior or senior standing, be majoring in early childhood education, & be admitted into the department of Curriculum & Instruction. Applicants must also complete the application and submit a 250-500 word personal statement.

Ruth Preston Mosser Future Educational Leaders Scholarship* Applicants must be enrolled in the Early Childhood Off-Campus Site (EchOS) Program. This scholarship is to help working adults who are completing their undergraduate degrees. Graduate students in the EchOS program are eligible to apply.

Erika St. Arbor Memorial Scholarship (\$500-\$1,000) Applicants must have a senior status, be majoring in early childhood education, & have a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

Department of Kinesiology & Health Education

Evan T. James Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000) Applicants must be a full time student at SIUE with a GPA between 2.5 and 3.5; have second, third, or fourth year status; be a student in the Exercise and Wellness program (preferably), or Physical Education Teacher Education program; & submit a 250-500 word personal statement.

Department of Special Education & Communication Disorders

The Thomas Wood Mosser Memorial Scholarship* Applicants must have a junior or senior status, be majoring in special education, & have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Traci Storey Student Scholarship (\$500) Awarded to a full-time junior, senior or graduate student majoring in the field of speech-language pathology, applicants must be an active member of the student organization, National Student Speech-Language-Hearing Association (NSSLHA) for at least one year and be nominated by students in NSSLHA, & submit an application to the Scholarship Review Committee.
